Nancy and I will celebrate 48 years together a few days before Christmas, and then will stay in Greenville to enjoy the Lord's Goodness to us with five of our six children and fifteen of our seventeen grandchildren. Jonathan, Kristi, Hudson & Kayla will be in our hearts as they celebrate their fifth straight Christmas in the Philippines where God has called them to serve as missionaries.

One of our Fone-Ev. counselors had a very special week reaching folks with the Gospel. Mike was a soldier from Fort Bragg, who heard our broadcast and called needing spiritual help. He had been in and out of many different churches through the years, some with very different doctrine, and though he had made a profession of faith in Christ, he was very confused still. She spent over an hour on the phone with him, and we were able, at his request, to sent him our follow-up courses through e-mail. That same week a lady from Greenville called asking help for her and her teen boy to be able to get to church. Our counselors's husband, one of our board members, and their pastor went by the home and were able to lead this teen to Christ. Another counselor had the joy of giving assurance of salvation to a boy from a town near Greenville.

We had a great meeting in Kentucky where five boys and girls came to accept Christ as Savior. We were pleased to find that the schools there were out for the whole week for a fall vacation. The reason we were invited to this meeting was that the church had planned for an October meeting and when the time drew near they discovered that the majority of their workers decided to go on vacation with their children. Because of this, we had to begin from "scratch." The pastor was eager to visit with us, and we were able to start with six visitors on the bus along with a few boys and girls from the church. With that small beginning we saw new boys and girls coming every night: many of whom had never been to the church before. The church van was making three trips each night and another lady used her van the last two nights to get more children in. Another exciting thing was that the church workers began getting more involved as the week went on and became wonderful friends. Thank you for praying: we had a close call on our trip there and the Lord wonderfully protected.

Our "dialer" ministry has been calling into Gaffney, SC - about fifty miles north of Greenville. We have had some good comments from Christian people there, and praise the Lord, an opportunity to lead a seventy something year-old lady to Christ. She had attended church all her life, but had never put her trust in the finished work of Christ until now.
